

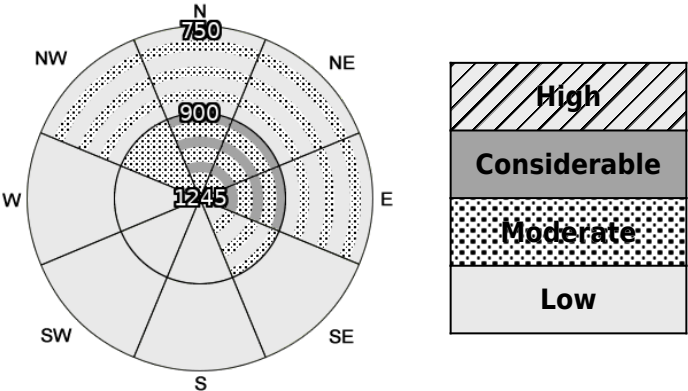

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 09/02/2012

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snow pack will become saturated in the surface layers, which will lead to further instability of the poorly bonded windslab on mainly North-West through North to East aspects above 900 metres where avalanches are likely. Elsewhere much of the ground is scoured and the limited snow pack though moist will be well bonded and stable. Cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level will be at 2000 metres for the forecast period. Occasionally heavy rain overnight with moderate South-West winds. Rain lessening in the day with light Westerly winds.
