

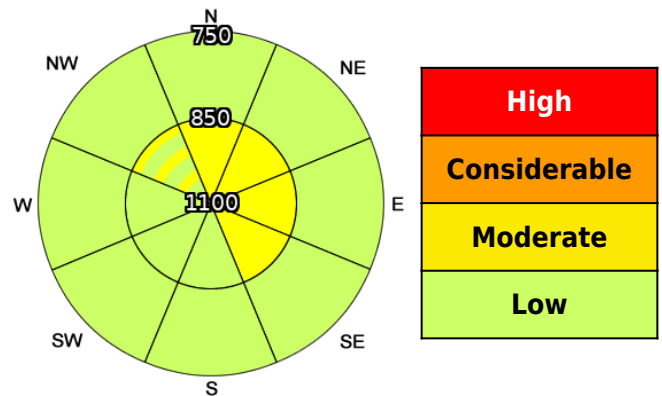

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 09/02/2012

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Further consolidation of the snowpack will occur although surface layers will moisten in the milder conditions. Stability of any recently formed cornices which exist above steep North-West through East to South-East aspects will be questionable, highest instability will be in the event of heavy overnight rain where cornice collapse and wet snow slides are likely. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

A band of rain, heavy at times, becoming patchier will be accompanied by moderate South-Westerly then lighter Westerly winds. Freezing levels will be just above summits with a midday of plus 3 degrees Celsius on the tops.
