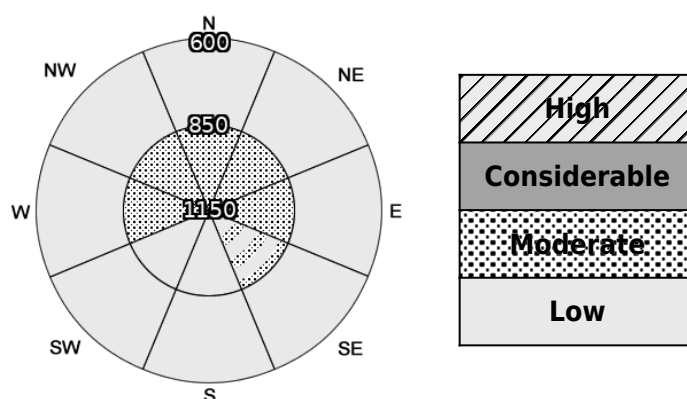


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE MODERATE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 10/02/2012****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The snowpack will continue to slowly thaw at all levels, it will remain generally well bonded on most slopes. However, on steep North-West through North to East aspects and mainly above 850 metres some localised wet snow, surface instabilities will exist. Areas particularly affected will be gully exits and steep scarp slopes, cornices will be soft and prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate

**Forecast Weather Influences**

The freezing level will remain above the summits with outbreaks of light rain and Southerly winds.

Comments

A mild and cloudy forecast with summit temperatures around plus 3 or 4 degrees celsius. Falling ice is a potential hazard.
