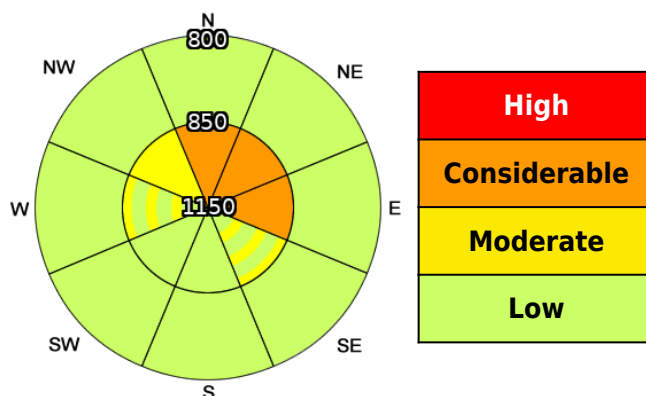


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 10/02/2012****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Snow will continue to thaw at all levels. Poor to weakly bonded layers will persist in deeper accumulations mainly on Northerly to Easterly aspects above 850 metres. Cornice collapse and ice fall will also continue to provide a significant hazard. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

It will be a dry, mild and cloudy day. Winds will be light from the South-West.

Comments

Weaker layers still exist within the snowpack. Careful route choice should be made as regards routes and travel.
