

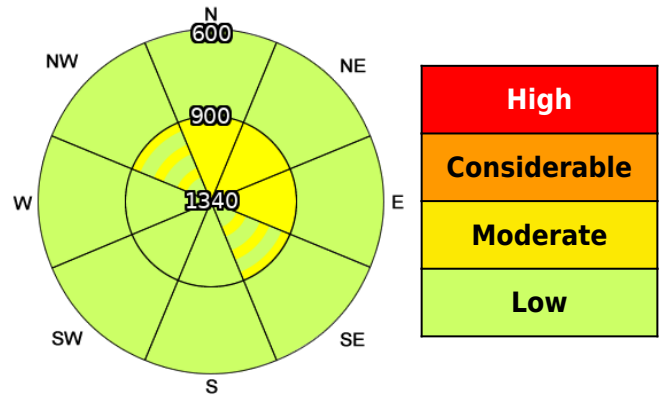

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 11/02/2012

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to slowly thaw and become increasingly moist. Instabilities will remain in the snowpack on steep slopes, mainly on North to East aspects above 900 metres. Remaining cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight rain is expected to become lighter during the day, with the freezing level at 1400 metres. The wind will be moderate, South-Westerly overnight, veering Westerly and North-Westerly during the day.
