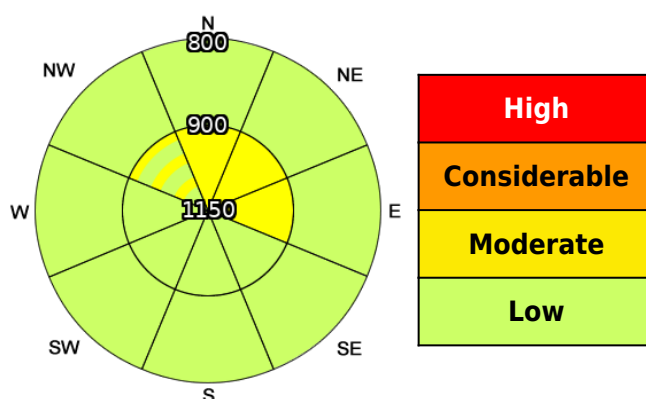


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE MODERATE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 11/02/2012****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Initially snow above 900 metres may be crusty but this will soon soften. Generally the snowpack will continue to consolidate with moderately to poorly bonded layers remaining mainly on Northerly to Easterly aspects above 900 metres. Collapsing cornices, rock and ice fall will continue to provide significant hazard during thaw conditions. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

The freezing level will settle around 1400 metres and there may be some light rain. The moderate winds will be from the North-West.

Comments

Cornices, rock and ice fall will continue to provide significant hazard.
