

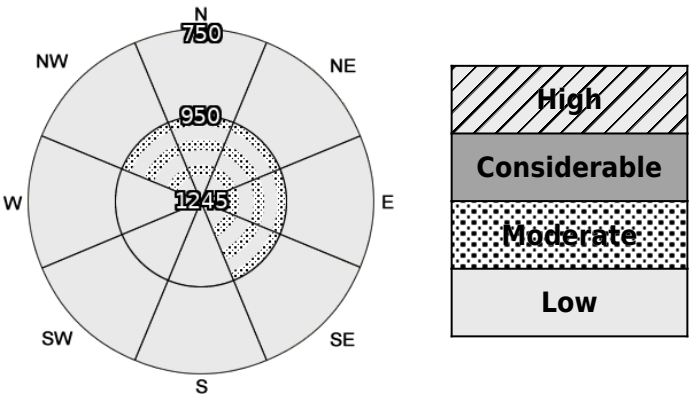

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 12/02/2012

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

At the highest levels small insignificant accumulations of new snow will develop on East to South aspects. In general the snowpack surface will re-freeze and consolidate in the cooler temperatures. Localised instabilities will affect steep and convex terrain on North-West through North to South-East aspects above 950 metres. Elsewhere the snowpack will be generally well bonded and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

There will be the odd snow flurry overnight and the winds will be light to moderate North-North-Westerly. The freezing level will fall from 1200 to 900 metres.

Comments

Existing faceted particles are beginning to round in milder temperatures, this will also help to improve stability.
