

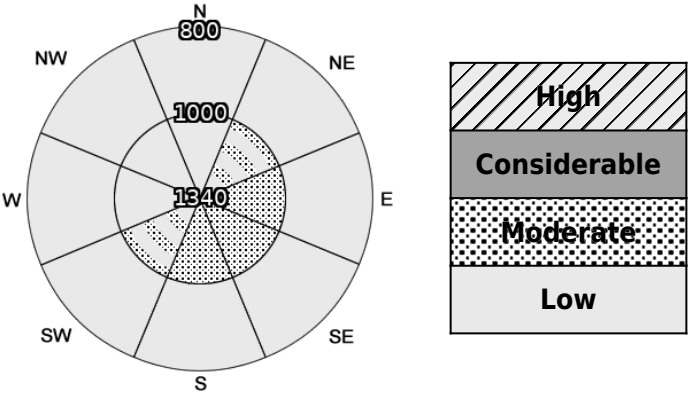

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 13/02/2012

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The existing snowpack will remain generally stable. Fresh deposits of unstable snow will form in the snow showers. Where deposits are of significant depth, these shall be moderately bonded. Greatest accumulations will be on steep East, South-East and South aspects above 1000m. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Light snow snow showers are expected overnight and during the day with strengthening North-West winds. The freezing level will rise briefly overnight to around 1100m but fall to 900m by the morning.
