

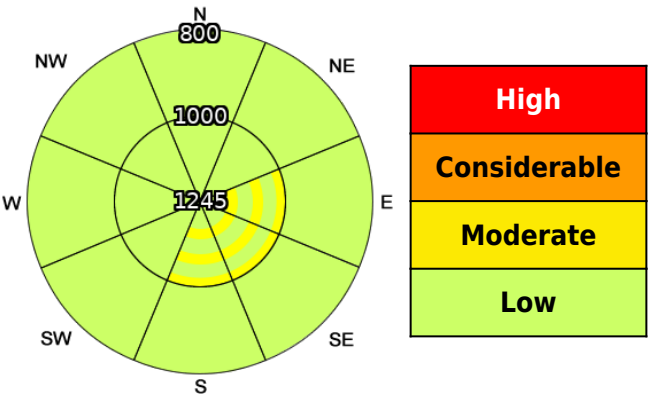

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 14/02/2012

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The existing snowpack will become more firm and stable in the cooler temperatures and will generally be well bonded. Some isolated accumulations of new snow may form moderately well bonded windslab in pockets and hollows on mainly East to South-East aspects above 1000 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight it will be dry with strong North-West winds and a freezing level of 800 metres. In the day the North-Westerly winds will strengthen and precipitation will fall as sleet or snow at summit levels. The freezing level will be at 1000 metres.
