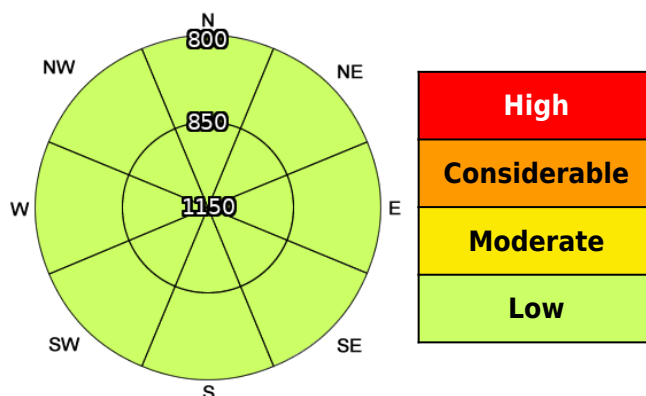


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 14/02/2012****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The snowpack will refreeze overnight and will become well bonded and stable at all levels on all aspects. During the day the risk of cornice collapse as well as falling rocks or ice will increase as the day warms. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Throughout the forecast period there will be no precipitation. Winds will be strong North Westerly. An overnight freezing level of 800 metres will rise to 1000 metres during the day.

Comments

Despite absence of snow at low levels full winter conditions exist above 800 metres.
