

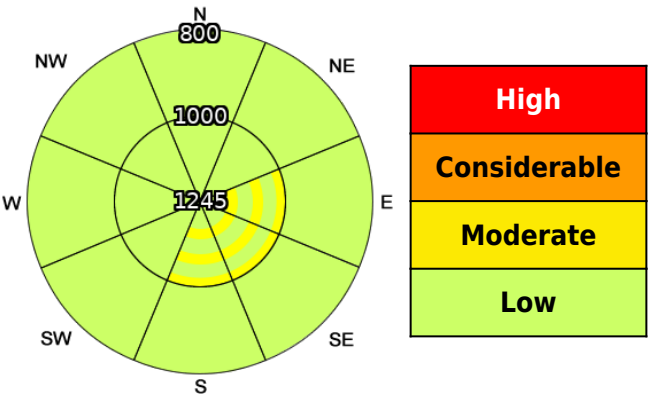

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will remain generally well bonded and stable on all aspects and altitudes. Some new accumulations of moderately well bonded windslab may form on East to South-East aspects above 1000 metres, these will be confined to wind protected hollows and pockets. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level will remain at summit levels throughout the forecast period and winds will be strong North-Westerly. Some light precipitation falling as sleet or snow is expected overnight, fading away in the morning.

Comments

Snow cover sparse but not disappearing.
