

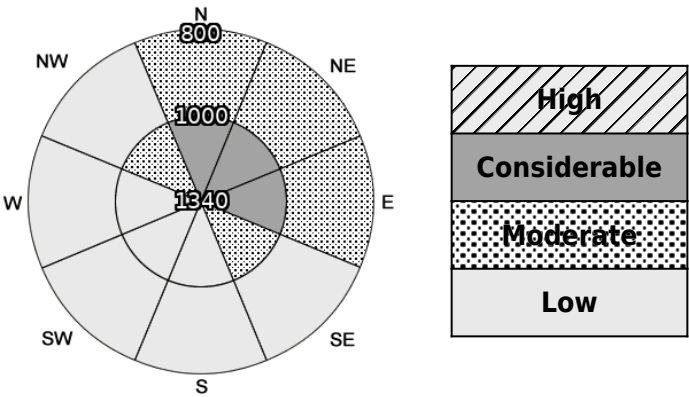

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 17/02/2012

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Overnight the existing snowpack will consolidate and will be generally stable. During the day accumulations of new windslab will be deposited on North to East aspects mainly above 1000 metres. This will become increasing unstable as the freezing level rises through the afternoon. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will be a dry night with a freezing level of around 1100 metres. During the day precipitation is expected, initially falling as snow above 800 metres. This will turn to rain below 1200 metres as the freezing level rises above the tops. Moderate winds will be from the South-West.
