

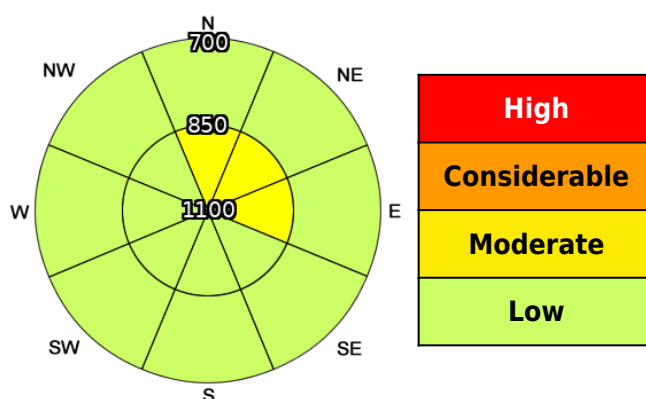

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 17/02/2012

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Areas of windslab will develop in sheltered locations on mainly North to East aspects above 850 metres, although cross loading of deposits will occur on other aspects. Accumulations of windslab will be localised and generally avoidable but they will be moderately to poorly bonded where they overlie refrozen older snow at higher elevations. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level will lower to 1000 metres overnight before rising to above the summits on Friday afternoon. Light snow showers will be accompanied by strong South-Westerly winds.
