

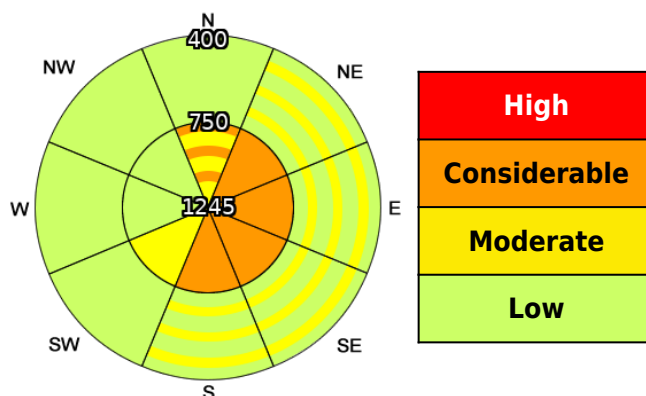
THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 19/02/2012

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Significant drifting is expected and weakly bonded windslab accumulations will continue to develop. Avalanches are likely mainly on North-East through East to Southerly aspects above 750 metres. Instabilities will also affect North and South-West aspects due to cross loading. Cornices will be unstable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will be freezing at all levels with heavy snow showers overnight becoming lighter and less frequent during the day. Winds will be moderate to strong North-West backing Westerly.
