

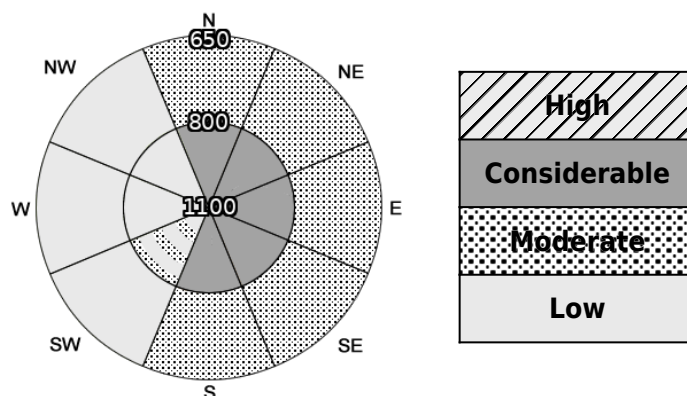

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Unstable windslab will continue to be loaded on to all North-East through East to Southerly aspects above 800 metres where avalanches are likely. Newly formed cornices will be prone to sudden collapse. All wind-exposed locations will be hard or crusty and well-stabilised. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Remaining very cold with snow showers continuing throughout. Winds will be strong North-Westerly easing later and becoming Westerly.

Very careful route choice required in present conditions.
