

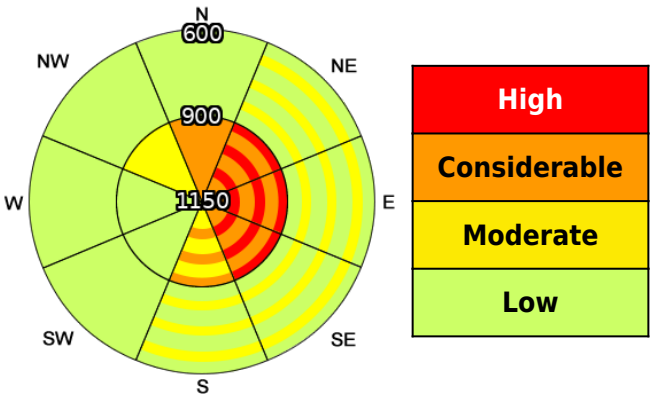

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 20/02/2012

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Areas of soft windslab will go through a period of poor stability as the freezing level rises and the snowpack becomes saturated in the wet conditions. Avalanches will occur on North-East to South-East aspects above 900 metres. Cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be High.



Forecast Weather Influences

A significant change in the weather is expected. After some overnight snow, the freezing level will rise to about 2000 metres and heavy rain will fall.

Comments

An unpleasant hill day expected on Monday. Rock and ice fall will be an additional hazard in the wet conditions.
