

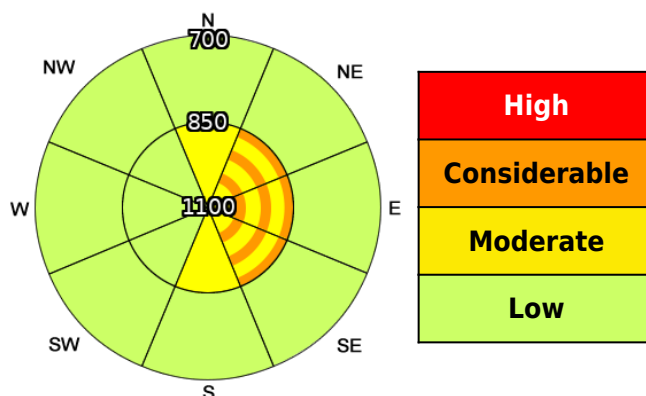

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 22/02/2012

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

There will be a slow improvement in snowpack stability below 850m on North-East to South-East aspects but localised wet snow instability will persist above this altitude. Locations immediately below cornices will continue to be threatened with high potential loading from remaining collapse-prone cornices. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Remaining mild and very wet. Winds will be strong South-West, later West-South-Westerly.

Comments

Most cornices are down but those that remain will become more unstable in very mild and wet conditions. 35mm to 60mm of rain possible overnight and during the morning.
