

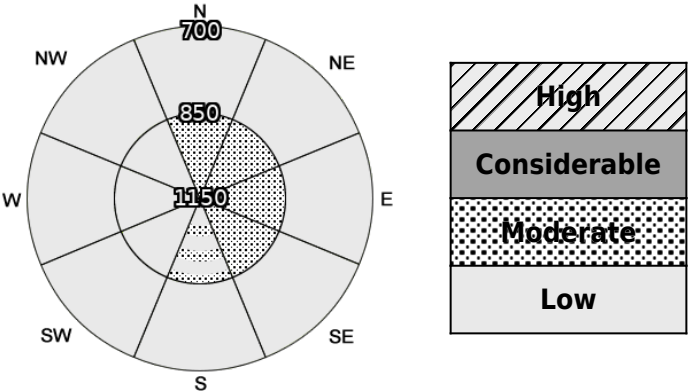

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will become increasingly wet at all levels. Wet snow instabilities will persist on steep slopes, mainly on North-East to South-East aspects above 850 metres. Remaining cornices will be unstable and prone to collapse. Stability on Western aspects will generally be good. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

It is expected to remain mild throughout the forecast period with heavy rain at all levels. Winds will be strong South-Westerly then West-South-Westerly.

Comments

Rockfall and icefall will be a hazard in these strongly thawing conditions.
