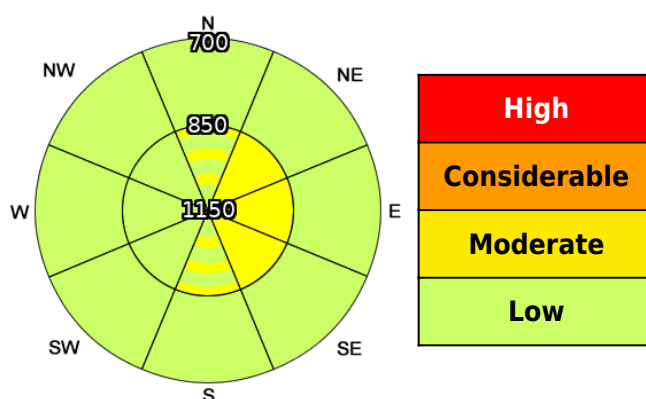


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE MODERATE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 23/02/2012****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The snowpack will continue to thaw and slowly consolidate at all levels. Wet snow instabilities will persist on steep slopes, mainly on North-East to South-East aspects above 850 metres. Any remaining cornices will be prone to collapse. Snowpack stability on Western aspects will generally be good. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

The freezing level is expected to remain well above the summits throughout the forecast period, with rain at all levels. Winds will be very strong and strengthening South-Westerly.

Comments

Rockfall remains a hazard in these wet and thawing conditions.
