

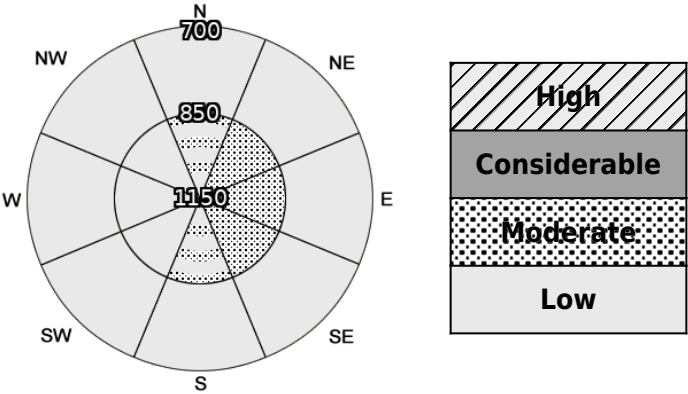

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to thaw and slowly consolidate at all levels. Wet snow instabilities will persist on steep slopes, mainly on North-East to South-East aspects above 850 metres. Any remaining cornices will be prone to collapse. Snowpack stability on Western aspects will generally be good. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level is expected to remain well above the summits throughout the forecast period, with rain at all levels. Winds will be very strong and strengthening South-Westerly.

Comments

Rockfall remains a hazard in these wet and thawing conditions.
