

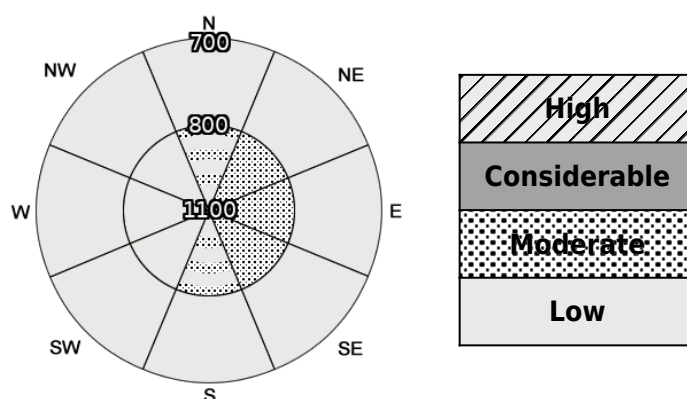

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 24/02/2012

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

As the freezing level drops remaining snow will become firm at all levels. Light new snowfall will lead to fresh moderately bonded accumulations forming in very sheltered locations mostly on North-East to South-East aspects above 800 metres. Other aspects may be affected due to cross loading. Areas exposed to the wind will remain well bonded and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

There will be very strong winds from the West with the freezing level dropping during the day to around 600 metres. There will be some very light new snowfall to valley level.

Comments

Looking cooler and windier for the next couple of days before another thaw sets in.
