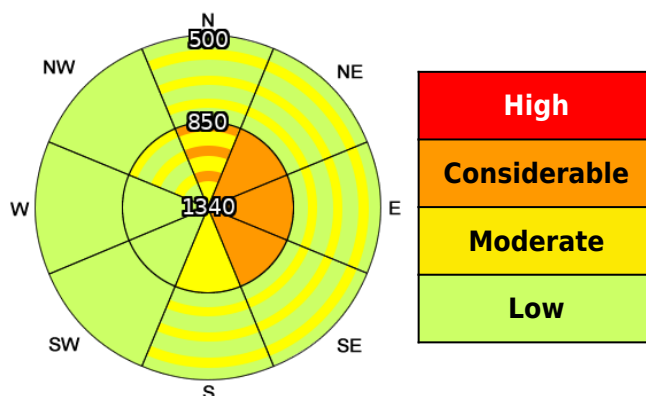


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 24/02/2012****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The surface of the old snowpack will re-freeze in the colder conditions. Fresh unstable windslab will be deposited in sheltered gullies, hollows and slopes, mainly on North through East to South-East aspects above 850 metres. New cornices will be fragile. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Winds are expected to be very strong Westerly. The freezing level is expected to drop from 900 metres to 600 metres overnight, remaining at that level during the day. Snow showers are expected throughout the forecast period.
