

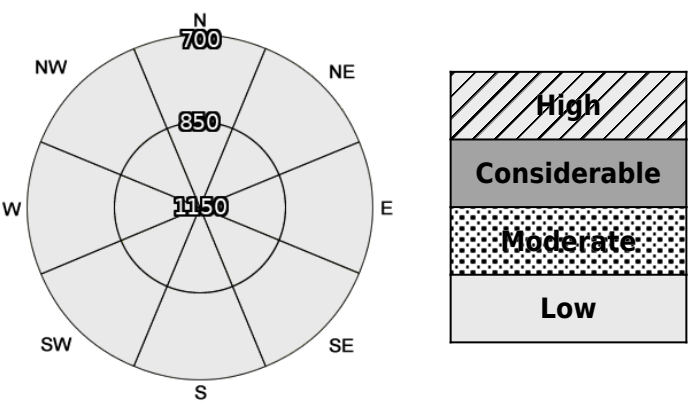

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 26/02/2012

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to slowly thaw but should remain generally well bonded in all locations and at all elevations. However, localised surface, wet snow instabilities with start to develop as the day progresses, cornices will also become soft and unstable. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level will rise to around 2000 metres with light rain, the winds will be Westerly and generally strong.

Comments

Overnight a brief period of sleet, then rain at all levels. It should be mainly dry in the morning then turning to more persistent and heavy rain.
