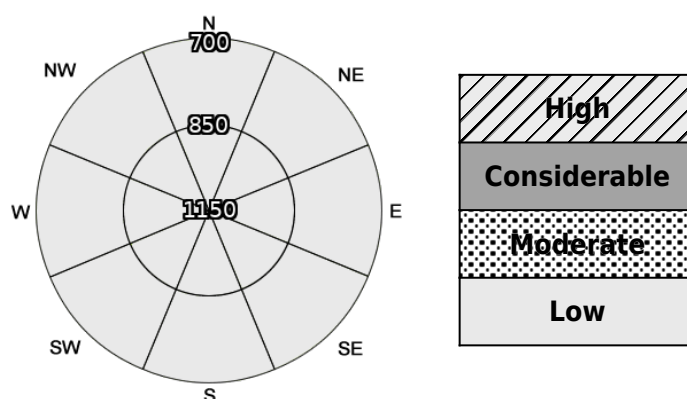


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 28/02/2012****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Little change is expected to the snowpack. Surface wet snow instabilities will be present on steeper slopes, mainly above 950 metres. Areas particularly affected are gully exits and steep scarp slopes on North-East to South-East aspects. Cornices will be unstable and prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Low

**Forecast Weather Influences**

The mild conditions will persist with the freezing level at 3000 metres. Rain and strong Westerly winds will back, becoming South-Westerly.

Comments

A very mild West to South-Westerly airflow is becoming established across Scotland. Summit temperatures around between plus 4-7 degrees Celsius. Beware of unstable cornices.
