

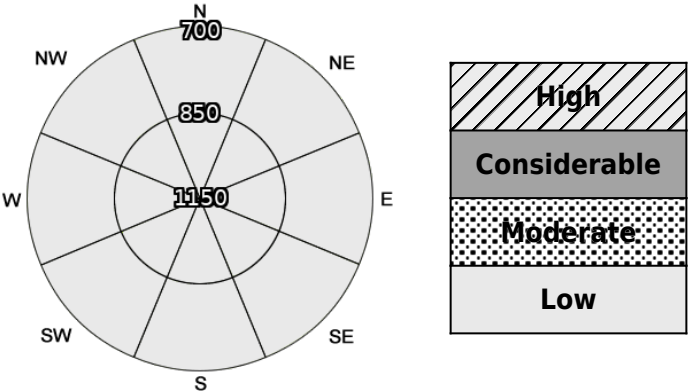

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 29/02/2012

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will consolidate in the drier conditions but will remain moist at all levels. Some localised wet snow instabilities may still exist on steeper slopes with a North to East aspect, mainly above 950 metres. Cornices, still unstable and prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Drier conditions with South-Westerly winds, the freezing level at around 2500 metres.

Comments

Some patchy drizzle is possible through the forecast period, the summit temperatures expected to be plus 5 to 8 degrees celsius.
