

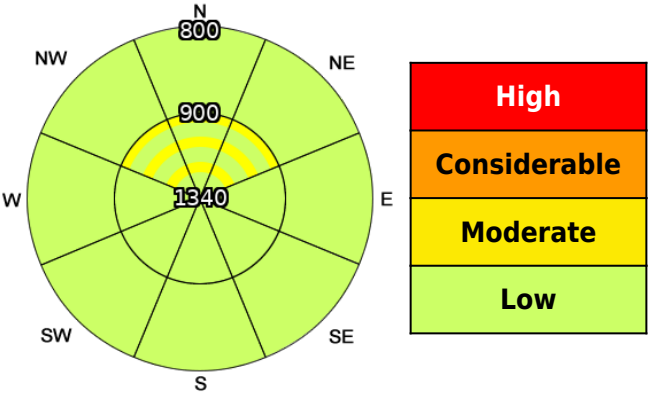

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 03/03/2012

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The existing snowpack will gradually freeze. Fresh areas of windslab will be deposited, particularly during the afternoon, on North-West to North-East aspects above 900 metres. These areas are not expected to be particularly extensive or deep. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Outbreaks of rain will turn to sleet on the summits by dawn, and then will turn to snow above 700 metres through the day. The freezing level will drop to about 900 metres. Strong winds will be from the South.
