

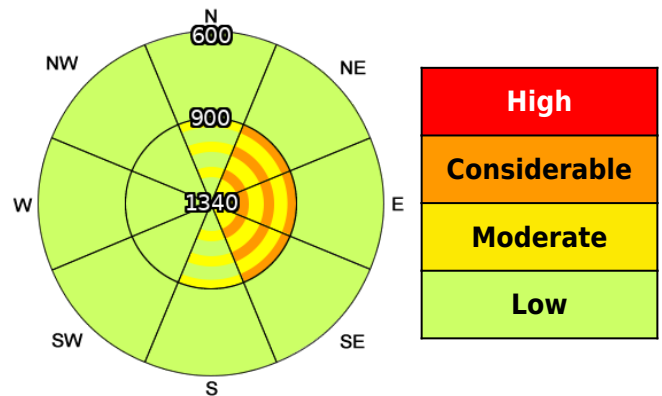

**Avalanche Problems**

**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Localised areas of unstable snow will be present mainly at the tops of steep North-East, East and South-East aspects above 900m. As the freezing level rises during the afternoon, wet snow avalanches are likely in these locations. In areas where the old snow is exposed, stability will be good. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



**Forecast Weather Influences**

A dry night with the freezing level around 750m. During the day, the freezing level will slowly rise to above the summits. Light snow showers will turn to rain at all levels and the winds will increase from the South-West.
