

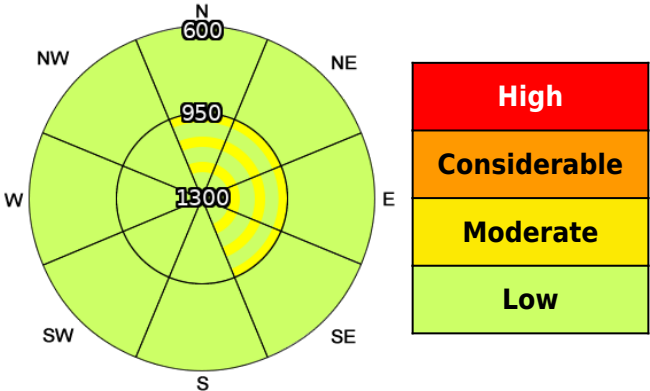

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 09/03/2012

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will diminish rapidly with wet snow instabilities likely on the steepest North-East to South-Easterly aspects above 950 metres where any fresh snow remains located. Elsewhere the snowpack will moist but generally stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

South-Westerly winds with rain will continue to strengthen overnight, only lessening slightly in the day as they become strong Westerly. The Freezing level will lower from 2000 metres to 900 metres by the end of the day.
