

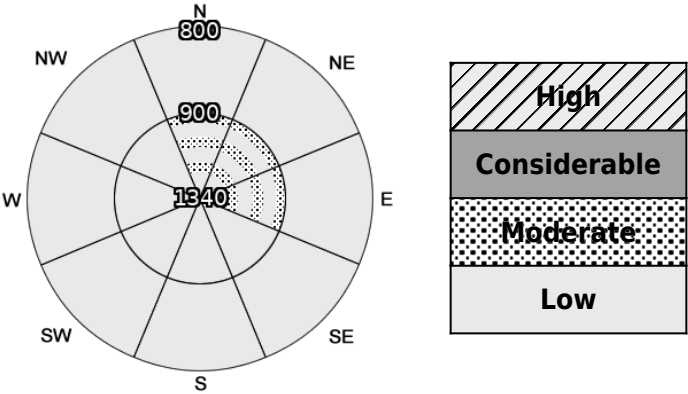

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to thaw and consolidate at all levels. Localised wet snow instabilities will persist on steep, mainly North to East aspects, above 900 metres. Elsewhere the snowpack will generally be stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight, the freezing level is expected to be around 1100 metres, rising above the summits during the day. Winds are expected to be strong Westerly, with some very light rain.
