

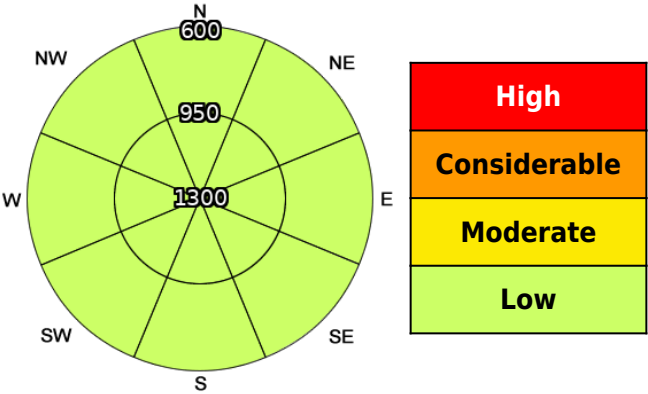

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack which exists mainly on North-East to South-East aspects above 950 metres will continue to thaw at all levels. In general the snowpack will remain well bonded and stable in all locations with only minor wet snow instabilities possible in steep terrain. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

It is expected to be mild and dry with strong Westerly winds.
