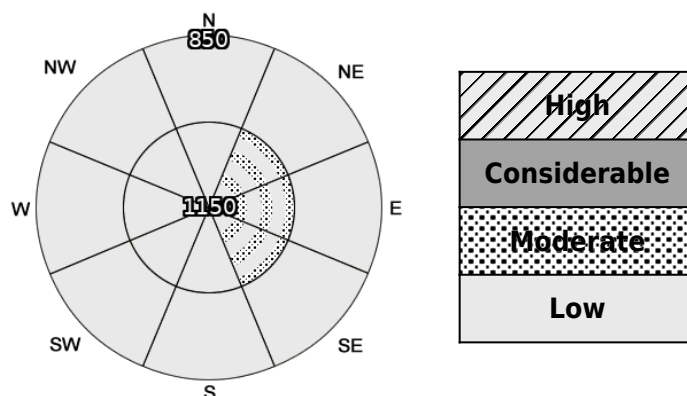


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE MODERATE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 18/03/2012****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Localised new snow deposits are expected to form in sheltered locations mainly above 850 metres. The greatest deposits will be on North-East to South-East aspects, where these accumulations form in depth they will be moderately bonded especially on steep slopes. The older snowpack will remain firm and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Cooler conditions will affect the area with the freezing level lowering to 650 metres. Some snow showers expected above 500 metres with strong Westerly winds these will veer becoming North-Westerly.

Comments

New snow amounts are uncertain but it will feel more wintry with fresh winds and summit temperatures around minus 1 or 2 degrees celsius.
