

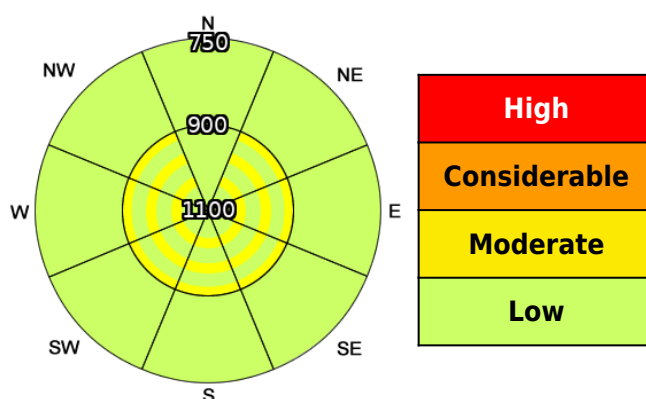

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Although becoming moist further consolidation of recent accumulations will continue to take place. Some new snow instabilities are possible above 850m with isolated pockets of windslab developing on multi-aspects, steep, sheltered gully flanks and coire rims being most affected. With overnight rain a period of higher instability will pass during which any recently formed cornices are likely to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Some rain overnight before turning to sleet /snow as Freezing Levels fluctuate around summits. Winds will be fresh North-Westerly
