

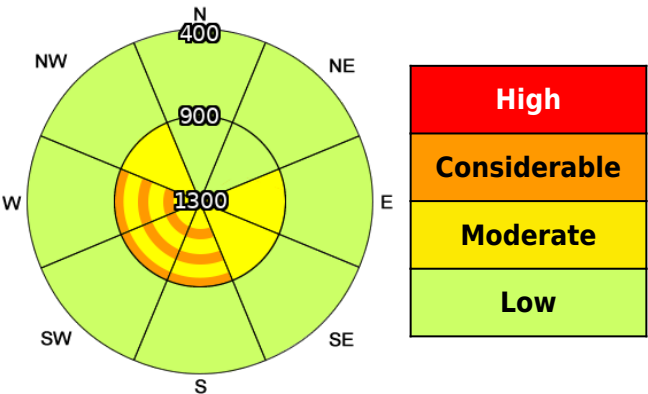

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to gradually stabilise and consolidate at all levels. However some instabilities will remain on mainly South to Westerly aspects above 900 metres, especially where windslab deposits persist in the deeper snowpack on steeper and convex terrain. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Sleet and snow overnight at summit levels turning to more persistent snowfall in the day as the freezing level lowers to 1000 metres. Winds will be moderate North-Westerly.
