

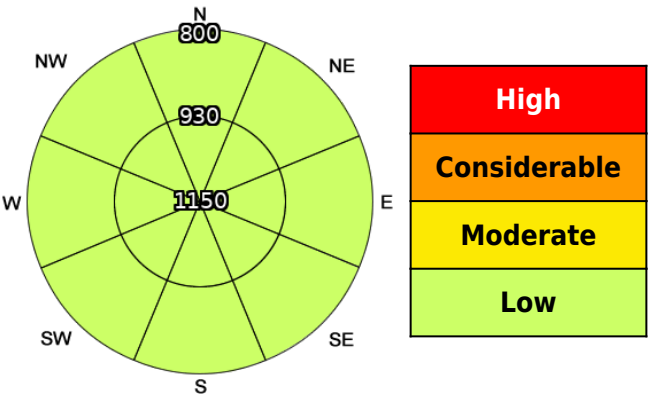

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 08/04/2012

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will remain generally well bonded in all areas, any new snow accumulations are not expected to be significant. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight, the freezing level will be at around 2000 metres, light rain at all levels accompanied by strong North-Westerly winds. During the day the freezing level will lower to 1200 metres with some light sleet over the summits, winds will back to the West and increase in strength.

Comments

Tomorrow's precipitation could well be just drizzle at first then light rain in the afternoon. More wintry weather with snow showers are forecast to return during Monday and Tuesday of next week!
