

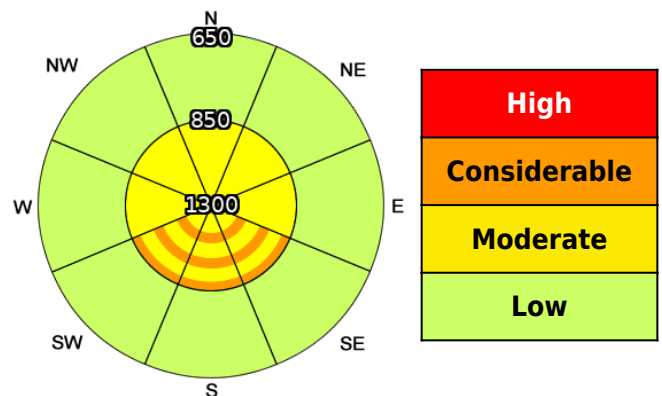

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Localised instability will persist on most steep South-East through South to South-West aspects above 850m. Fluctuating temperatures will bring some early consolidation to snow deposits in most other locations. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Freezing at all levels overnight then a slow rise in temperature during the day. A few patchy light snow showers are possible early in the night. Winds will be light North-Easterly increasing a little later. Sunny but becoming hazy.

Superb winter conditions for skiers and ski tourers. All the best off-piste runs near the ski area now tracked out. Weather forecast for Sunday even better. Next avalanche forecast for Northern Cairngorms will be published on Friday 4th May
