

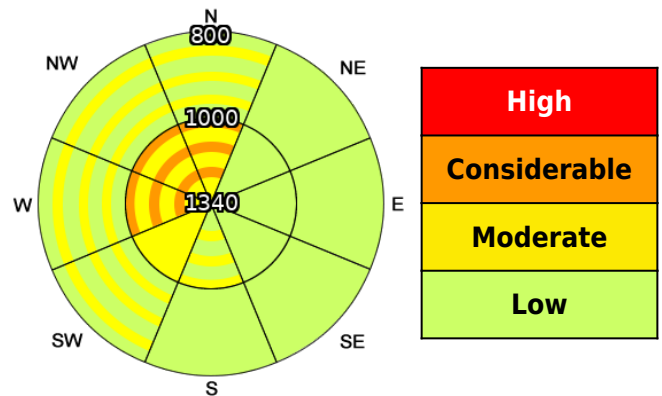

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 07/05/2012

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Through the day fresh areas of poorly bonded windslab will be deposited on West to North aspects, and in other sheltered locations above 1000 metres. On windward aspects stability will generally be good. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

After a dry night and early morning, a change in the the weather is expected. South-Easterly winds will strengthen considerably and initially light snow will become heavier through the day. The freezing level will rise from about 600 metres to 900 metres through the day.

Comments

Wintery conditions with strong winds and 10-15cm of fresh snow expected at higher levels on Monday.
