

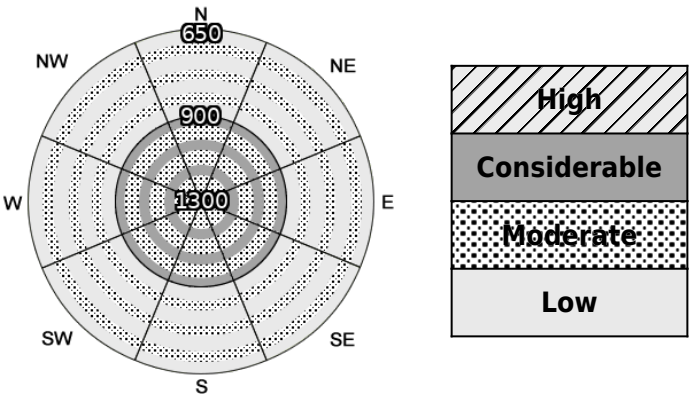

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Snowpack stability should improve in the colder and drier conditions and it will be generally moderately well bonded on all aspects below 900 metres. However weaknesses will remain in the snowpack on most aspects above 900 metres, steep slopes and convex terrain being particularly affected. Surface instabilities will also occur on sun affected slopes. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight, precipitation should gradually die out remaining dry during the day. Winds will be moderate at summit levels and will be Westerly. Freezing level 600 metres in the day gradually rising to 900 metres.

Comments

Good weather forecast for Saturday - grim for Sunday. Deep snow cover, knee deep in places - heavy going.
