

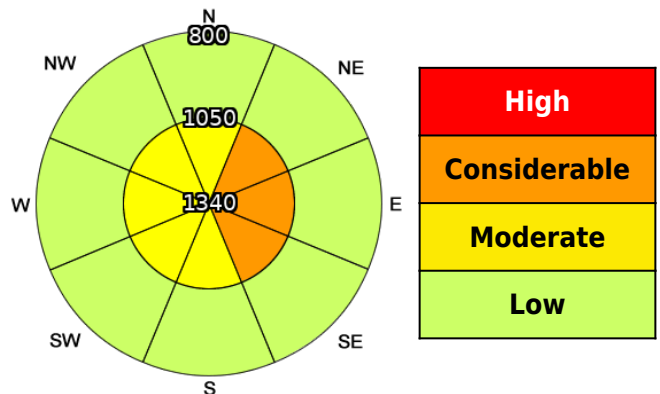
THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 13/05/2012

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will thaw in the mild and wet conditions. Instabilities are expected in the existing deposits of windslab. The most extensive deposits of this windslab are on North-East to South-East aspects above 1050 metres where avalanche are likely. Recently formed cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

A change in the weather is expected. After a generally dry night the freezing level will rise above the summits and heavy rain will fall at all levels through the day. South-Westerly winds will be very strong, with gusts of well over 100mph on the summits.
