

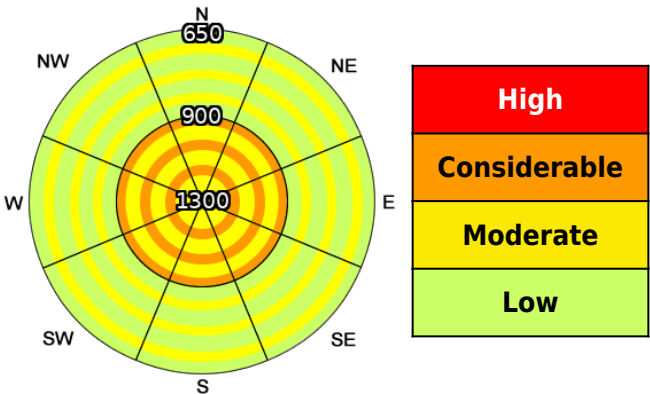

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will gradually moisten and weaken in the warmer temperatures, especially in steeper locations above 900 metres on all aspects. Cornices will be unstable and likely to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight, some light snow is expected with gradually strengthening South-Westerly winds. In the day the South-Westerly winds will become very strong and the freezing level will be above the summits and occasional light rain is expected at all levels.

Comments

Good ski touring, but with soft snow becoming heavy in the day. SW winds forecast to be gusting 100mph Sunday. Becoming colder and wintry midweek with more snow.
