

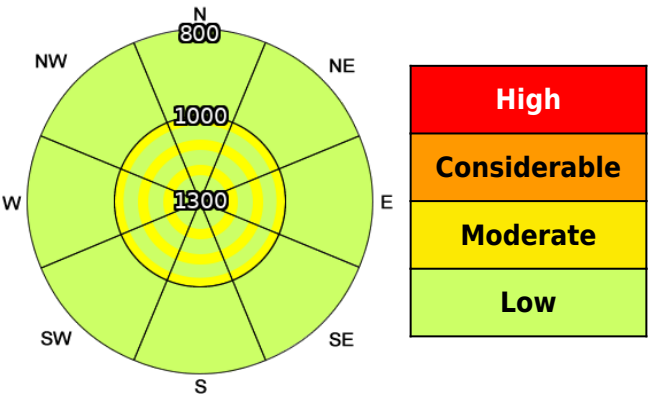

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

In general the snowpack will continue to consolidate; however localised instabilities will affect areas of steep and convex terrain above 1000 metres. Surface instabilities will develop on sun exposed slopes and cornices will be prone to collapse. Elsewhere the snowpack will remain well bonded and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

It is expected to be dry with light East becoming South-West winds. The freezing level will rise to above the summits by the afternoon.
