

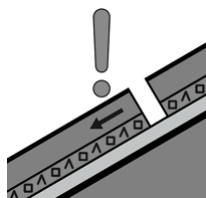

#### Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 15/12/2012

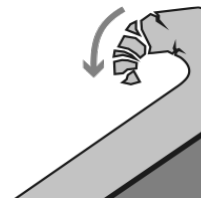
##### Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab



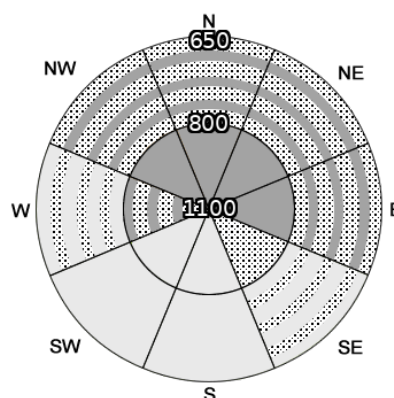
Persistent Weak Layers

##### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Weakly-stabilised windslab will continue to accumulate on steep Westerly to North-West aspects above 800m. An overnight wind-shift will bring about new marginally-bonded windslab development on all steep, sheltered North to East aspects above 800m. Avalanches are likely on all these aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



##### Forecast Weather Influences

Persistent snow showers overnight, lighter during the day before becoming heavier. Winds will be strong Easterly, later Westerly and easing during the day. Remaining cold but temperatures rising to just above summits later.

##### Comments

Ground and paths frozen again on Friday. Scouring noted in all wind-exposed locations.
