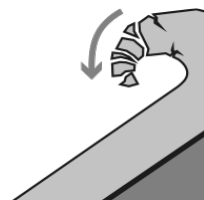

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 16/12/2012

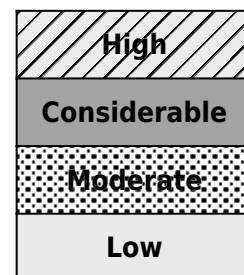
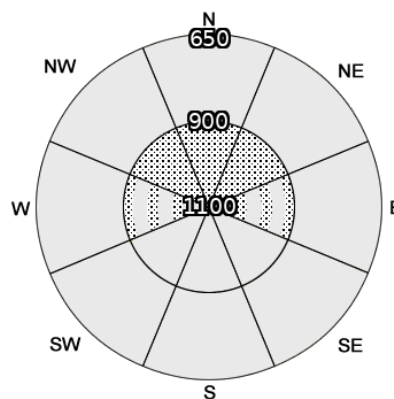
Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Localised accumulations of windslab will develop overnight on steepest North-West to North-East aspects and gully tops above 900 metres. The fluctuating and lowering temperatures during the day will see a general improvement in stability although pockets of marginally bonded windslab will persist primarily on, sheltered North-West to North-East aspects above 900 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

A few light snow showers overnight around summits, becoming mainly dry with freezing levels lowering to below 500 metres again by midday. Winds will remain strong mostly Southerly throughout.
