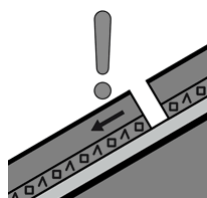


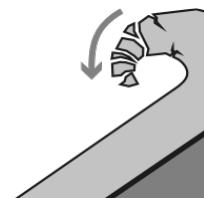

Avalanche Problems



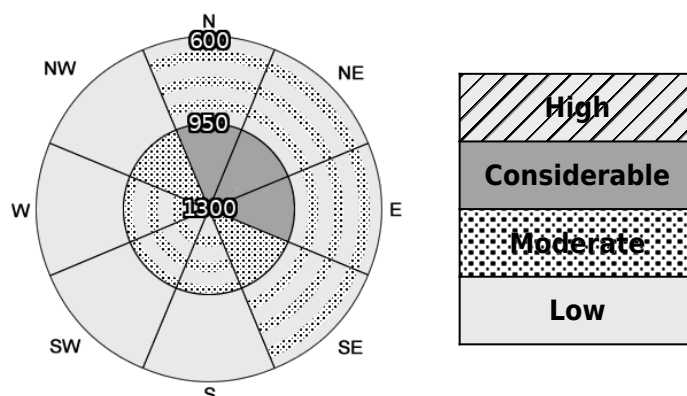
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Snowpack stability will improve with instabilities mostly affecting steep Northerly to Easterly aspects above 950 metres. Elsewhere the snowpack will be moderately to generally well bonded especially at lower altitudes. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Light snow will die out overnight and winds will be moderate South-Westerly backing Southerly. The freezing level will fluctuate at around 1000 metres.

Comments

Stability should generally improve during the milder fluctuating temperatures.
