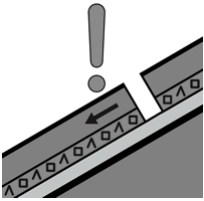


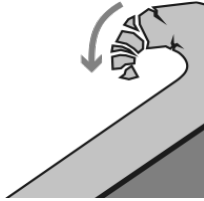

Avalanche Problems



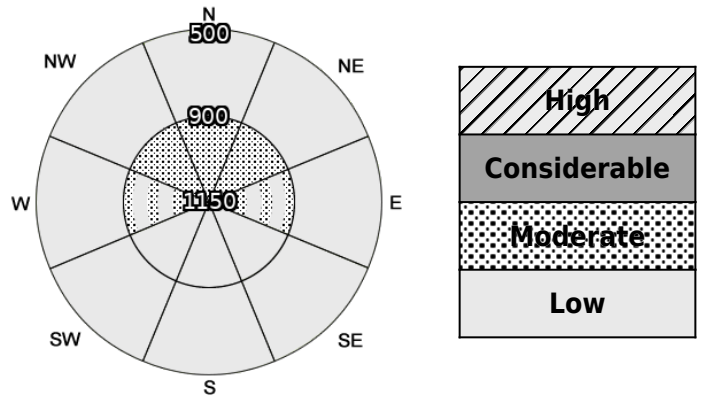
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little change is expected within the snowpack - slowly thawing below 900 metres. Localised instabilities will still persist at higher elevations mainly on steep North-West to North-East slopes and in gullies above 900 metres. Cornices becoming unstable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

It should be mainly dry through the forecast period with only an isolated shower falling as snow above 850 metres. The light winds will predominately be from an Easterly direction and the freezing level at around 1000 metres.

Comments

Wet bulb freezing level at around 900 metres will help snow stability above this elevation and thus improve climbing conditions.
