

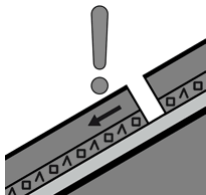

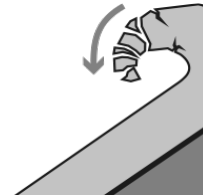

Wind Slab



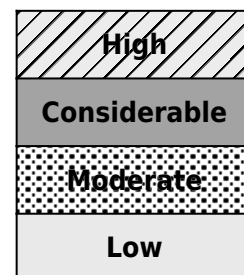
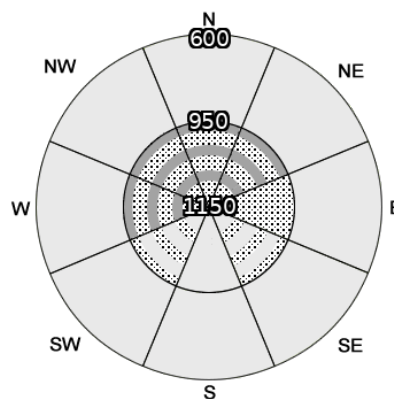
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Above 950 metres, localised poorly bonded accumulations will be found on steep terrain on Westerly through North to North-Easterly aspects. Greatest hazard will be on gully exits and scarp slopes. Elsewhere the snow will be moderately bonded on most aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level will be around 1000 metres. There will be no significant winds or snowfall.
