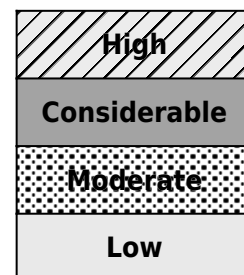
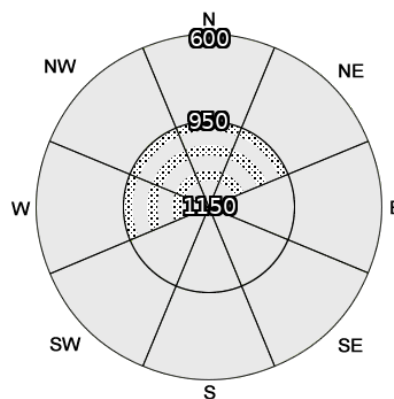
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Moderately bonded localised instabilities will remain on steeper terrain on Westerly through Northerly to North-Easterly aspects above 950 metres. Gully exits and corrie rims will be most affected. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Winds will become steadily stronger from the South-East becoming gale force by afternoon. There will not be any significant precipitation until later in the day. The freezing level will be around 900 metres.

Comments

Winds will be strengthening throughout the day and any new snowfall will be after approx 1700.
