

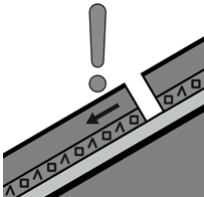

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 20/12/2012

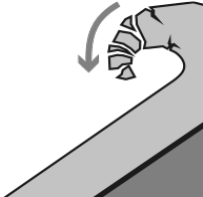
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab



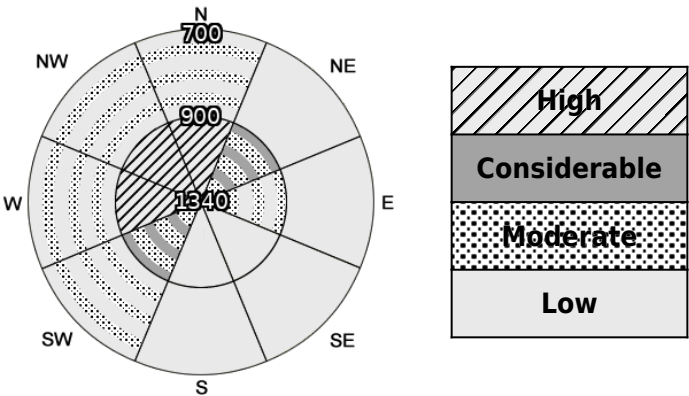
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Large areas of unstable snow will form in areas sheltered from the South-East winds. Greatest accumulations will be on West, North-West and North aspects above 900m. Hazard will increase during the day as the fresh snowfall becomes established. Avalanches will occur in these locations. Unstable cornices will also form above these aspects. The avalanche hazard will be High.



Forecast Weather Influences

Strong South East winds with snow above 750m. Heaviest snow during daylight hours.
