

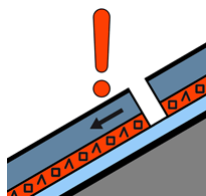

Wind Slab



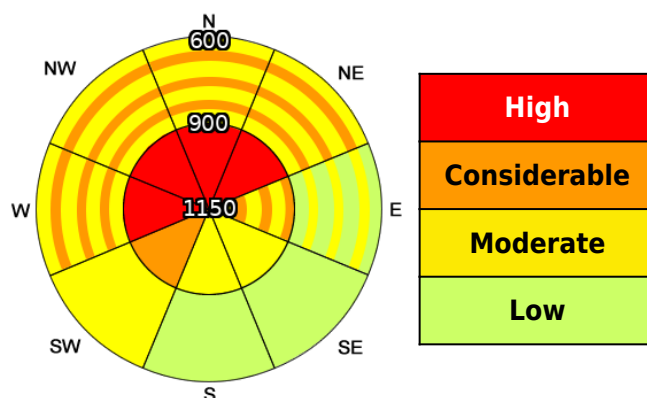
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Unstable windslab will develop in sheltered locations on mostly Westerly through North to North-Easterly aspects above 800 metres where avalanches will occur. Other aspects will also be affected due to cross-loading. New unstable cornices will also develop. The avalanche hazard will be High.



Forecast Weather Influences

Strong winds will be mostly from the South-East with heavy snowfall above around 600 metres. Freezing level will be at approximately 800 metres.

Comments

Likely to be a challenging day with heavy snow forecast throughout the day.
