

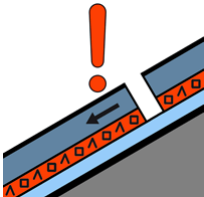

Wind Slab



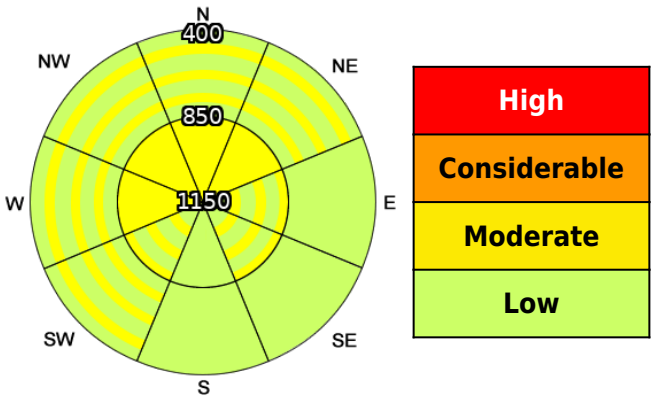

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Above 750 metres, new unstable windslab accumulations will form in sheltered locations mainly on West through North to North-East aspects, where avalanches are likely. Some other aspects will also be affected due to cross loading, gully flanks and exits particularly affected. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Strong South-Easterly winds and snow above 650 metres.
