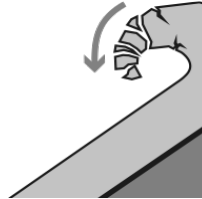

Wind Slab



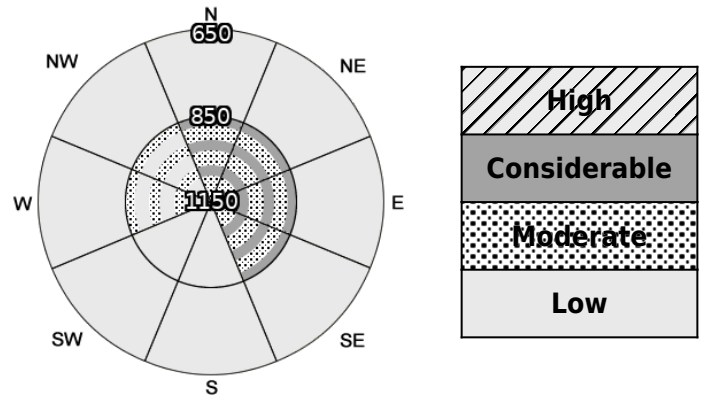

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

In general the old moist snowpack will continue to consolidate, and at higher levels start to refreeze. Fresh unstable, generally localised, windslab will continue to be deposited in sheltered areas, mainly on North through East to South-East aspects above 850 metres. Cornices will continue to be unstable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Winds are expected to be moderate, West-South-Westerly overnight and Westerly during the day. Showers, mainly light, are expected throughout the forecast period, sleet then snow above 800 metres. Freezing level around 900 metres.
